

**Proposed Amendments**

Article V – Meetings

Article V, Paragraph 3 – existing language:

Shooting events – During the shooting event and prior to the commencement shall not be classified as meetings. Announcements may be made at these times, but business shall not be conducted until the conclusion of said event.

Reason for proposed change – Fewer and fewer members are staying after the shooting events making it difficult to get member input on matters affecting ACSA. Business should be conducted when, as many members are present as possible, before or after a shooting event, during the end of year dinner or other times when large numbers of members are present at an event.

Proposed new language:

Shooting events – Announcements may be made and ACSA business conducted before or after shooting events in order to maximize the number of members present to consider and vote on matters affecting ACSA.

Article VII, Paragraph 3 – existing language:

No two officers shall be related by law or by blood.

Reason for proposed change – It is becoming increasingly difficult to get candidates to run for ACSA office. In some cases, spouses, children, cousins, nieces, nephews, etc., may like to participate on the ACSA Board, but are barred by the existing Bylaw language if a relative or family member is already on the board.

Proposed new language:

No more than two officers shall be related either by law or by blood.
